CASC MEMBERSHIP

SUBSCRIPTION 2019:

The annual subscription is £495.00.

Subscriptions are due on the 1st of January each year. Payment can be made by in advance or by 10 monthly instalments for which there is a small administration fee or by quarterly post dated cheques.

WHO DOES IT SUIT:

Limpsfield Chart Golf Club is open to the whole community without discrimination including those on low or modest incomes. Anyone able to demonstrate they cannot afford Full Membership will be entitled to join Limpsfield Chart Golf Club and participate fully for a cost of less than £520. The subscription fee for a CASC Member is £495 and an applicant will be able to borrow golf clubs for no charge (just a modest deposit is required). If the applicant cannot afford Full Membership, please apply in writing to the Secretary of the Club providing information and supporting documents to demonstrate that you cannot afford the Full Membership fee of £950/year.

Typically, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Having an annual income of less than £12,000 per annum
- Have savings or assets of less than £8,000

In addition, the applicant must be in receipt of one of the following state benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit

CASC Members are allowed full access to the golf course within the specified days and times – these are any two days per week from Sunday to Wednesday, after 3pm from 1st April to 30th September and after 1pm from October 1st to March 31st and they may participate in any competitions that are played within these allotted hours of course access.

CASC must comply with the Club's standard code of dress and conduct on the golf course, at all times. Any breach of either code could result in the withdrawal of playing rights, to be decided by the Club Management Committee.

CASC Members can use the services of the Club Professional at the published professional tuition rates.

CASC Members can use the Clubhouse facilities but they must conform to the Club's dress code and Rules of Behaviour whilst in the Clubhouse. Any breach of these codes or Rules could result in the withdrawal of rights to use the Clubhouse facilities, to be decided by the Club Management Committee

CASC Members can book tee times in advance, within the allotted playing hours.
